

Moving house?

Here is a handy list of what you need to do before the big day.

- Inform your bank, building society, insurance company and any credit card providers that you are moving.
- Notify TV licencing, HMRC and the DVLA that your address will be changing.
- Set up a mail forwarding service via the Post Office and update your address on websites such as Amazon, Ebay & PayPal .
- Arrange for your utilities such as gas, electric and water to be switched off at your current house when you move out. Don't forget to read the meters.
- Organised for utilities to be connected to your new address on your moving day.
- Collect up all keys for your current home inc. spares with family members etc. and deliver them to your estate agent or solicitor.
- Organise for your phone and internet service to be transferred to your new home. It is advisable to do this in advance in case your new property doesn't have a current connection.
- Make a list of any useful contact numbers and addresses such as estate agents, solicitors (both your own and your sellers), insurance companies, utilities (and account numbers) in case you need them.
- If you are moving to a different area, notify your doctor, dentist and optician.
